The eighth graduating class from the Virginia Human Services Training owned one special distinction: it was the first to graduate everyone of the students who began the program.

Graduation ceremonies were held at the Piedmont Virginia Community College's Dickinson building Sept. 3

As VHST Director Paul Abrams pointed out, that was no small feat. Anyone studying to receive the Human Services Certificate must make a key switch — from consumer of mental health services to provider of those services.

The 11 who began the 21-credit Consumer Provider Training Program successfully made that switch and are now guaranteed at least a half-time position at their home agency.

Besides two graduates sponsored by Region Ten, the class of

2008 had graduates sponsored by boards in Chesterfield, Richmond, Midlothian, Timberville and Staunton.

VHST honored the memory of past-graduate, Danielle Lingg, a Region Ten CSB consumer provider who died in the spring.

Abrams announced the creation of the Danielle Lingg Memorial Award for Academic Excellence.

That award was presented to Kevin Kelly.

Abrams concluded the graduation ceremony with these words:

"So, congratulations. You have survived many struggles, you have taken on significant new personal and professional responsibilities and you have become the carriers of the message of hope and recovery to others who are beginning their own journey back from mental illness."
