CLASSIFICAITON TITLE: Substance Abuse LPN

GENERAL STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITIES:

This is a FLSA non-exempt position. The incumbent serves as a Substance Abuse Nurse in Region Ten Community Services at the Mohr Center. In this capacity he/she has responsibility for providing delivery and administration of medications and for providing consultation to other clinical staff regarding consumer health care issues.

The incumbent reports to the Director III and performs duties by proceeding alone under standard practices and referring questionable situations to the supervisor. In carrying out position duties, he/she performs in accordance with applicable professional ethics and established Region Ten policies, Virginia Board of Nursing, Virginia Board of Pharmacy and Community Resource Pharmacy (CRP) policies.

The HIPPA access level for this position is Level Two

The essential functions of this job are starred below (*) under "Major duties."

MAJOR DUTIES:

- 1. *Assumes charge and triage functions on the day and evening shift, in the absence of the Mohr RN, as well as shared responsibility for the medication program including timely and accurate delivery of medications, ordering and tracking of medications; working directly with the CRP and local pharmacies to implement physician's orders.
- 2. *Provides consultation to other clinical staff regarding acquisition of consumer medications and consumer health care issues.
- 3. *Maintains complete and current clinical records and service provider data (Credible), including physician orders and all contacts with residents.
- 4. *Review MAR each shift as needed and compare with physicians orders in Credible for accuracy.
- 5. Check PRN meds periodically for expiration. Complete paperwork to discard meds and complete when two nurses are present.
- 6. Complete inventory sheet for PRN meds once a month.
- 7. *Check medications for current consumers for accuracy of label and to ensure sufficient quantity. Notify day charge nurse of any medications that need ordered.
- 8. *Clean med room periodically, replenish supplies.
- 9. Orient and support tech staff in required duties as needed.
- 10. Provide counseling and support to consumers and provide oversight on overnight shift for appropriate clinical and medical consumer care.
- 11. Review team folder periodically and stay current on updated procedures.
- 12. Review contents of nurse's office, cabinets, closets throughout Mohr facility to be familiar with supplies and location.
- 13. *Scan physician orders.
- 14. Receive verbal orders from physicians, enter in Credible and MAR; Enter medications under orders tab.
- 15. Assist with admissions.
- 16. Process pharmacy receipts.
- 17. Assist in supervising visiting hours.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The incumbent in this position must be a graduate of an accredited program and be licensed (LPN) to practice in the Commonwealth of Virginia. In order to ensure the safe and efficient fulfillment of any travel on behalf of the Board, a valid Virginia driver's license plus an acceptable driving record as issued by the Division of Motor Vehicles are required. For use of a personal car to conduct business, a certificate of valid personal automobile insurance must be provided. The incumbent must possess the following knowledge, skills and abilities:

<u>Knowledge of</u>: substance abuse and serious mental illness, psychopharmacology and medication side effects, phlebotomy, medical issues related to substance abuse and mental illness; family individual and group techniques; crisis intervention; biological sciences and disease processes; substance abuse symptomology.

<u>Skills in</u>: assessing needs of individuals with substance abuse diagnosis as well as those with serious mentally illnesses; planning appropriate intervention; delivering and administering medications; completing venipuncture; providing consultation; maintaining clinical records; communication with a wide range of people; crisis intervention; multiple therapeutic techniques; personal computers and keyboard usage.

Abilities to: teach clients/families about substance abuse and mental illness and medications; deliver and administer medications; communicate effectively with all staff, clients, and other agencies; complete paperwork and required

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documentation; work cooperatively as a team member with other care providers; receive work direction from RN's and clinic Services Director.
