What is REACH?

The REACH program is designed to meet the crisis support needs of individuals who have a developmental disability and are experiencing crisis events which put them at risk for homelessness, incarceration, hospitalization, and/or danger to self or others. REACH programs offer an additional layer of support to emergency services, the state hospital system, and caregivers who work most closely with individuals with a developmental disability (DD).

Who is eligible for REACH services?

REACH is a lifespan program that serves children and adults across the state.

In Region I, Easterseals UCP provides REACH services to adults ages 18 and up.

Individuals must have a documented intellectual and/or developmental disability AND co-occurring mental illness and/or significant behavioral challenges.

REACH can be contacted 24/7 via the crisis line at 855-917-8278. However, in the event that someone is a danger to themselves or others, please <u>call 911</u> and request assistance from emergency responders first, and then follow up with a call to REACH.

REACH Mobile Crisis Team

- 24/7 REACH crisis hotline
- Consultation with crisis clinician via phone
- On-site response for crisis assessment within 2 hours
- Development and training on individualized Crisis Education and Prevention Plans
- Linking to community service supports
- Training on prevention and stabilization strategies

Mobile Crisis Services

- Implementation of crisis stabilization plans in home and community settings
- Coaching/mentoring the system of support

Crisis Therapeutic Home

- Six-bed short-term residential crisis stabilization (up to 30 days)
- Structured daily therapeutic schedule
- Therapeutic groups, activities, and community outings
- Skill-building exercises (ADLs, social skills, etc.)
- Emotional recognition and regulation
