I. Call to Order

Ms. Barrett called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM.

II. Welcome

Ms. Barrett welcomed everyone to the meeting.

III. Comments from the Public

IV. Chair's Remarks

Ms. Barrett indicated there was no Chair report.

V. Executive Director's Remarks

Region Ten became the Fiscal Agent for LIPOS, DAP Funds, Espert Funds, and Training Funds. Region Ten runs Adult REACH, and also has the Regional Office. More and more the goal is to have CSBs run regional programs. Region Ten, as the Fiscal Agent, has become the lead CSB for our region.

Working on implementing Crisis Continuum in STEP VA. This would involve a call center for the region. 911 calls, crisis calls, etc would come to the call center and be screened to see if the police are needed, or different services. This will take a few years to put into place. This is an underfunded endeavor. Region 1 has agreed to send out an RFP for the call center. DBHDS has aligned the crisis continuum to the Marcus Alert system.

The other implementation is Adult Mobile Crisis. Children's Mobile Crisis is handled through Horizon. The Adult version will be run out of the Regional Office at Region Ten. The long-term goal is to integrate the two mobile crisis units run by an interdisciplinary group.

We get money through a SOR Grant, which only pays for 50% of people's positions. We have been unable to cover the other half. We are moving those funds out of OBOT, join with Addiction Allies, then handle IOPs through the counties.

VI. Consent Agenda

Ms. Barrett asked for approval of the consent agenda. Mr. Murphy motioned to approve the consent agenda and Ms. Whitehead seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

VII. Other Business

Ms. Whitehead indicated there was a short Fundraising Report for review in the packet.

The agency is offering one more Covid-19 vaccination clinic to cover second shots for residential staff and consumers.
