



Admissions Exclusionary Criteria

Candidates will be excluded from admission if any of the following conditions apply:

- **Suicidal ideation or intent** – Actively suicidal. Recent attempts within the past 3 months are reviewed case-by-case in consultation with the provider.
- **Homicidal ideation or intent** – Actively homicidal or posing imminent risk to others.
- **Primary psychosis not related to substance use** – Includes persistent psychosis, delusions, or hallucinations not expected to resolve with detox/stabilization.
- **Unable to perform ADLs at the level supported by the program** – Client cannot independently manage basic self-care needs.
- **Requires medical or rehabilitative services beyond program capacity** – e.g., active physical therapy, chemotherapy, dialysis.
- **Pregnancy in the third trimester** – Excluded for maternal/fetal safety. First and second trimester clients must have an OB-GYN evaluation prior to admission.
- **Pain management with narcotics and unwilling to transition** – Clients refusing non-narcotic alternatives.
- **Tier 3 sex offenders** – Not eligible for residential care; may be considered for outpatient levels (currently PHP).
- **Active eating disorders requiring specialized care** – e.g., anorexia or bulimia with medical/nutritional management needs.
- **Requiring supplemental oxygen** – Indicates medical acuity beyond program capacity.
- **Other conditions outside program scope** – Candidates whose medical, psychiatric, or specialized needs cannot be safely managed at this level of care.
